## **Prostate Health Awareness Event**



Saturday 12th April 2025, at the Mary Forryan Centre, Leicester Road, Hinckley, LE101LW

Coventry & North Warwickshire Prostate Cancer Support Group are delighted to have the opportunity of returning to the Mary Forryan Centre to hold a repeat of last year's highly successful Prostate Health Awareness Event.

It is a sad fact that prostate cancer affects more men than any other cancer, so that 1 in 8 men will experience it in their life time. In fact, 53,000 men are diagnosed every year. Despite all this, there are no screening or awareness programmes. And so we see well known men from the media and world of sport going public in order to draw attention to the risk and the need to get tested. The clear message is "early detection saves lives: in fact if caught early enough prostate cancer can be cured. However, 80% of early cancers have no symptoms, so men need to be proactive and get tested from the age of 45".

Additionally, certain groups are more at risk than others. Black and African-Caribbean men are at twice the risk: likewise, men whose father and/or grandfather have prostate cancer. Such men should be tested from the age of 45, or ideally 40.

Men over the age of 50 are entitled to what is called a PSA test. This test measures the health of a man's prostate and can indicate the presence of cancer. Unfortunately, GPs don't make eligible men aware of this test, or call them in. So, it is left to local patient-led charities like Coventry & North Warwickshire Prostate Cancer Support Group to raise awareness and highlight the need for early testing.

So, we are delighted to provide this opportunity to have a PSA test in the Mary Forryan Centre, Leicester Road, Hinckley on Saturday 12th April from 10:00am to 1:00pm. You are asked to book



a 15-minute time slot in advance: this saves time on the day and minimises queuing. Book online at cnw. mypsatests.org.uk or via the QR code. A £20 registration fee is required to help cover equipment and processing costs.

## Happy Ending as Brandy is Rescued

The photograph on this page may look distressing at first but worry not – the story has a happy ending.

On Sunday, 16 February fire crews were called to the aid of a horse named Brandy, who had fallen into Ashby Canal.

Crews from Leicestershire Fire and Rescue Service Market Bosworth, Leicestershire Fire and Rescue Service Hinckley Station and a water rescue team used an inflatable rescue path and slide sheets to help him out of the water with the assistance of farm machinery.

By this time, according to firefighters: "Poor Brandy was exhausted."

They said: "Eventually he got back on his hooves and was helped home to his nearby stable, where Brandy was warmed by his owners and cared for by a local vet. We understand he is recovering well from his ordeal.

"Please take care around bodies of water in these continuing cold, wet conditions. If you



find an animal in distress, always contact the appropriate animal or rescue organisation."

A spokesperson for Hinckley and Bosworth borough Council described the incident as: "A reminder to take care around bodies of water and what to do if you find an animal in distress.

"It is good to hear that Brandy is recovering well. Great work from LFRS and everyone else involved."

## **Consultation Open on Chemists**

People living in Leicestershire communities are being given the chance to have their say on local pharmacy services, with a consultation now open.

Every three years, pharmaceutical needs assessments (PNAs) are carried out around the country to ensure that local community pharmacies are meeting the pharmaceutical needs of local people.

The PNA helps the local NHS to manage and make decisions about requests from pharmacists or pharmacy businesses to set up new community pharmacies, merge businesses, or move premises within Leicestershire.

It also considers the accessibility and effectiveness of service delivery. They also provide insight into other areas where improvements can be made.

Councillor Louise Richardson, cabinet member for health and wellbeing, said: "The Health and Wellbeing Board has a statutory responsibility to prepare a Pharmaceutical Needs Assessment (PNA) for Leicestershire every three years.

"The Health and Wellbeing Boards across Leicestershire have come together to carry out this survey to gather your views on current services. I would encourage everyone to take part in this survey so that we have a clearer picture of what future services may be required."





The Boards will publish the results of initial survey, and these will be used to help prepare the draft pharmaceutical needs assessment which will be consulted on later in the year.

# **Batteries Warning After Bin Lorry Fire**



Fire chiefs are urging people not to dispose batteries in bins after a bin lorry was forced to dump its burning load onto a Barwell street after a fire started inside the vehicle.

It happened on Powers Road during a morning collection round and fire crews from Hinckley station were called to the scene at around 8.13am on Valentine's Day.

People had to stay indoors and keep windows closed because of smoke billowing from the fire.

A video was taken by a resident and has been shared by Hinckley and Bosworth Borough Council (HBBC) on social media, show fire crews dealing with the incident.

Craig Hallam, station manager, Community Safety, at Leicestershire Fire and Rescue Service said: "Lithium-ion batteries are extremely sensitive to high temperatures and inherently flammable. Batteries should always be disposed of in an appropriate designated battery container and should never be put in a general waste bin or mixed with other waste, as they contain toxic and corrosive materials that can

cause fires."

A council spokesperson said: "If you have old/ dead batteries to get rid of, please take them to your local recycling centre, or to a dedicated collection point which you can find in many shops and supermarkets that sell batteries."

## Plan to Control Mink and Protect Water Voles

Minks, an invasive semiaquatic mammal, have been significantly damaging the population of native water voles in Leicestershire.

Now a policy to control them in the county has been approved.

Females can enter burrows to hunt water voles, which are unable to escape.

Leicestershire County Council's cabinet passed the plan to support the conservation of water voles, which environmental groups

say have declined by 97% nationally since 1950, largely due to mink.

A document explaining the policy states only live-capture traps can be used on minks and any non-target species must be released unharmed.

It adds that methods to "capture and dispatch" mink are "humane, safe and targeted".

The authority said while there is no definitive answer on the population of mink in Leicestershire, there has been a decline due to ongoing mink control.

The council said this new scheme allows for a common policy across Leicestershire to control mink population.

A council spokesperson said "We have



identified the water vole as a priority species in our Local Nature Recovery Strategy and are working with the Water Vole Recovery project to help boost their numbers in Leicestershire.

"Any work to control mink in the county would follow the highest national standards and would not be a threat to any other animals."

The Leicestershire and Rutland Water Vole Steering Group (LRWVSG) has an agreed vision to support water vole recovery in the two counties, which includes the "humane control" of mink population.

The species is native to North America but was brought to Britain in the 1920s to be farmed for fur. Some escaped and others were released by animal rights activists.
