Ada Lovelace Goes to College!

A campaign for Hinckley to become the home of a stunning new sculpture of one our area's most celebrated and historic figures has taken a massive step forward.

It has now been agreed that the sculpture of Ada Lovelace will be situated outside the Hinckley campus of North Warwickshire and South Leicestershire College.





Ada Lovelace grew up in Kirkby Mallory and not only was she the daughter of legendary and infamous English poet Lord Byron - she has gone down in history as the first computer programmer!

Ada spent her childhood years at Kirkby Mallory where she was encouraged to develop a love of science and mathematics.

She is considered to be one of the first computer programmers following her work with Charles Babbage's Difference Engine, which is a calculating machine which required a written program to carry out complex calculations.

A spokesperson for the campaign said: "The statue will be virtually opposite the Museum, a

building she would recognise today, passing it many times with her grandmother travelling to and from Kirkby House, Kirkby Mallory."

Work on casting the statue is beginning this month! taking approximately 16 weeks.



Give to Gilbert's Globetrotters

Readers may have heard over the past couple of weeks about Gilbert's Globetrotters – and seen a number of fundraising events taking place.

It's all part of a push to raise money in honour of Jade Gilbert, a teacher at Hinckley's Battling Brook Primary School who passed away last year.

Miss Gilbert had a huge impact at the school and Gilbert's Globetrotters was set up to raise money for a new gym – one of her passions.

The original target for Jade's Gym's fundraising page was $\pounds4.500$, although the total cost for the gym is estimated at more than $\pounds16,000$. Over $\pounds12,000$ has already been raised!

A spokesperson said: "Jade was an incredible lady who had a positive impact on anyone who came into contact with her. Her zest for life and enthusiasm in everything she did made her a pleasure to be around. Her infectious laugh was a common sound that could be heard throughout the school. This is why we feel so strongly that her memory must be honoured, and a suitable tribute must be created as a legacy to the impact that she had on so many in our community."

Events took place from Wednesday 9th until Friday 11th April, including cycling event in Richmond Park, which was attended by MP Dr Luke Evans.

All children at the school have been taking part in daily PE lessons/activities and staff have been continually using equipment (provided by Empire Fitness in Hinckley) to chip away at a total distance of 25,000 miles.

Empire Fitness also ran a class called Combat Fitness for the appeal.

Dr Luke Evans said it was a "Pleasure to be down at Richmond Park to kickstart the big family bike ride as part of the Battling Brook Primary School Gilbert's Globetrotters fundraising event.

"Great to see so many families out, enjoying the excellent weather and getting in lots of laps of



the park in memory of Ms Gilbert.

"Well done to everyone involved in organising the event and to Battling Brook Primary School PTFA for running the refreshment station!"

Over the months from messages and comments I have received I have discovered all types of people who have read these articles. Many have Parkinson's, or perhaps they have family and friends with Parkinson's, or some other debilitating illness. Others just like to keep themselves informed.



The monthly Carer's Group

meeting tries to feature helpful information about assistance available, perhaps with Council Tax or mobility issues – the Blue Badge can be a very helpful addition when walking from a car is an issue. Some conditions or chronic illnesses are not immediately obvious to others and for some people this can make it hard to understand and believe that someone, with a "non-visible" condition genuinely needs support. Some people question whether you have a real problem because "you don't look like you have a disability.".

With that in mind in the latest Parkinson's Hinckley Group Newsletter is a feature about the Hidden Disabilities Sunflower. Simply by wearing the Sunflower, you are letting everyone know that you might need extra help, understanding, or just more time. This idea was launched in the UK in 2016 and all sorts of businesses ranging from retail, tourism and transport have joined this worldwide scheme. People might be wearing a sunflower badge or lanyard, or have it displayed on a car, where it will indicate to rioadside or emergency services that someone in the vehicle has an impairment which may not be visible.






The hub offers a warm and engaging environment focused on enhancing quality of life.
