Well 12-year-old Zac is having another great year – and has just finished in third place in the prestigious British Motorsport Championship at Whiton Mill, beating some of the best drivers in the country.

After successful 2023/4 seasons

Zac, who attends Hastings High School, has entered several British Championship events in 2025 in addition to competing in the TVKC championship at PFI international, racing against the best teams and drivers in Europe.

At the season opener British Motorsport Championship 'O' Plate event Zac achieved a third-place finish in the final, after strong performances in qualifying and the heats.

"We can honestly say that we feel joyful after each visit and are really fortunate to have met him. We are sure that there are so many benefits for our young person, but, equally, there are so many for us."

Since taking early retirement, David Robbins has been involved in several volunteering roles and has never looked back.

"It has definitely added a lot to my life and allowed me to get involved with lots of different projects after retiring. It is the perfect combination of both learning new skills and using those you have developed in your working life. I'm really grateful for the opportunities it has given me and would encourage anyone to get involved."

Christine Radford, lead member for adults and communities, said: "Planning for later life takes many forms, and volunteering offers a wealth of benefits to individuals. It's extremely heartwarming to hear the positive impact it's having on people's lives.

"With such a wide range of volunteering programmes, residents can get stuck into anything from the home library service to country parks."

Run by dedicated volunteers supported by Leicestershire County Council's Family Help Service, they provide a safe, fun

and engaging space for little ones to explore, learn and develop essential life skills.

Jane Moore, director of children and families, said: "Stay and play sessions are a fantastic way for children to learn and grow while providing parents with a welcoming and supportive community.

"These sessions offer creative activities that boost confidence, improve social skills, and support early years development.

"They also offer a great opportunity for parents to connect with others, share experiences and



#### access valuable support."

Studies show that early play enhances cognitive skills, language development and motor skills, helping children build social awareness, problem-solving abilities and emotional resilience.

Stay and plays allow children to learn at their own pace in a relaxed and reassuring atmosphere.

# **Benidorm in a Banger for Barwell's Miracle**

# Twins

The parents of a pair of miracle twins from Barwell who were born an incredible five days apart are this May taking on an epic challenge.

Emma and Tom Day will be driving over 1,300 miles from Napton to Benidorm in a car that's just scraped through its MOT!

They said: "Over the course of four days, we'll cover this incredible distance alongside 112 other cars and 350 participants. But unlike the others, we are the only team in the rally raising money for ADAPT Prembabies, a cause that means the world to us."

ADAPT is a small but vital charity supporting families with premature and poorly babies in the neonatal units of Leicester Royal Infirmary and Leicester General Hospital.

They provide hands-on emotional and practical support, helping parents through the toughest days, both in the hospital and after their babies go home. Their work is completely self-funded, meaning every donation makes a difference.

Tom and Emma's boys Axel and Alfie were born in 2013 and spent five months in hospital rigged up to life-saving machines but were back home in time for Christmas.

They said: "Our twins, Axel and Alfie, were born four months early, five days apart. Axel weighed just 1lb 12oz, and Alfie 2lb. ADAPT was there for us in those terrifying times, and now, nearly 13 years later, our boys are thriving, proving that with the right support, miracles happen.

## **VE Day 80 commemorations**

Parishioners are invited to commemorate the **80th anniversary of VE Day** at a beacon lighting on Far Lash open space on the evening of **Thursday May 8**.

**Village Crier** Russell Kew will echo a proclamation being made in communities across the kingdom and the Burbage beacon will be lit as part of a national act of remembrance at **9.30pm**.

A tribute to those who made the ultimate sacrifice and all who were affected by or played a part in the 1940-45 conflict will be read by the Council Chairman, Cllr David Bill.

The anniversary event will be followed on **Sunday May 11 with a community street party**, reminiscent of those held across the country 80 years ago to celebrate the declaration of Victory in Europe at the end of the Second World War.

Tables will be set along Grove Road for parishioners who have paid for



seating, and there will be informal picnic space around stalls in Pughes Paddock, plus live music from **Dean Thomas** and **Four Play**.

 Grove Road will be closed to traffic between 10am and 6pm, from the junction with Twycross Road to the junction with Love Lane. There will be no access to Grove Road or Grosvenor Crescent during those hours. Residents are asked to ensure that vehicles are not parked on the streets during the closure period. Diversion routes will be signed.

The Council's Principal Officer Juliet Perry said: **"We appreciate residents' support for what we hope will be an enjoyable event for the whole village."**

## Artificial grass pitch unveiled at Hinckley Rugby Football Club

#### A new artificial grass pitch has been unveiled at Hinckley Rugby Football Club by local MP, Dr Luke Evans.

Dr Luke Evans, Member of Parliament for Hinckley and Bosworth, joined players and supporters of the Club to unveil the new 3G grass pitch following Hinckley RFC's successful application to the previous Government for a grant of £150,000.

The artificial pitch is critical to enabling Hinckley Rugby Football Club's (HRFC)

Community Programme to support young, disabled, elderly and disadvantaged users to participate in sports in a safe and accessible environment while providing health and wellbeing opportunities across the community.

#### Dr Evans said, "The project was a combination of sports such as football and rugby, local bodies and Government all working together to deliver the much-needed facilities in Hinckley."

In November 2023 the local MP wrote to a Minister under the previous Conservative Government, Jacob Young MP, to support the Club's application. Dr Evans said "HRFC have a clear track record of delivering high quality and sustainable sporting opportunities to the local community. Therefore, I am pleased to write this letter in support of the Community Ownership Fund bid to refurbish the 3G pitches which risk being lost to the community."

The new pitch was unveiled ahead of a pre-match lunch at the Club in aid of Prostate Cancer UK. Later in the afternoon, the Hinckley Hornet's played Exeter University.

Vicky Macqueen, Commercial Manager at Hinckley Rugby Football Club, said "We are super grateful for the support of Luke



Evans in officially opening our 3G pitch. His endorsement of our work at the Club and application for funding has been so valuable in helping us to support and serve our community with this amazing new facility!

"We thank him and his team for their time, and continued support of Hinckley RFC and our wider community!"

Dr Luke Evans, Member of Parliament for Hinckley and Bosworth, said "It's said that a community that plays together stays together, but you need facilities to do just that."

"The opening of the artificial grass pitch at Hinckley Rugby Football Club is great news for our community, providing another fantastic sports facility for people of all ages to enjoy.

"Hinckley RFC are a credit to our town, it was a real pleasure to join the team for the opening of the pitch and to see so many supporting the Club and celebrating the new facilities which were quickly put to use by the younger players!

"The day was topped off with a terrific prematch lunch at the club, in aid of Prostate Cancer UK. Congratulations to John Tilley, Ross McMurran, Vicky, Ross Cunningham and the whole team for securing this investment for our area."
