Charity Riding School Appeals for Help Following Theft

Staff at a riding school for disabled people are appealing for help after being devastated by thieves who stole a quad bike and caused thousands of pounds worth of damage.

The burglary happened in the early hours of the morning in late March at the Nuneaton and North Warwickshire Equestrian Centre in Galley Common.

The manager of the riding school said a group of youths, who were captured on CCTV, raided the lock-up, took a specialist quad bike and destroyed fencing as they fled.

The school's manager said they were "absolutely disgusted" by the thieves behaviour and the burglary had made the young people and adults who visit the centre "very anxious".

They added that the piece of equipment that had been taken "was not just a basic quad" and would cost about £10k to replace.

The riding school, which has supported children and adults with disabilities for 46 years, is a registered charity.

"The majority of the people who work here are volunteers, and they give up their time," the manager added.

"To steal from a charity is absolutely devastating."

A GoFundMe page had been set up to help pay for the repairs, but the manager said it had attracted criticism in the comments.

"People say we are begging and shouldn't be asking for money because that's what insurance is for, but people don't understand how charities work.

"We do rely on the goodwill of our local



community and the people that we serve.

"We are asking for generous donations, and that's what charities are dependent on to deliver a really valuable service."



Going Wild for Wild Swimming

Recent studies have revealed that wild swimming in lakes or rivers is linked to significantly higher levels of well-being compared to swimming in open-air pools.

Jayne said that all the people she swims with tend to agree on the following things:

"This should be available on the NHS" and "no



matter how difficult it is dragging yourself out for a swim, you never regret coming."

As for the mental wellbeing benefits, Jayne said: "It clears my head of any stresses or worries. There's something about seeing nature whilst you're actually submerged in it.

"Even if you swim at the same place you'll always experience something new there."

There are also social benefits. Jayne said: "It's also a great way to meet new people. There's something about the cold water that makes you feel alive.

"There are more venues now, and personally my favourites are Burton Hastings (complete with oystercatchers, goats and cafe) Dosthill and Stoney Cove (both are beautiful, amazing quarries, popular with divers. Dosthill is smaller but makes up for up with a bespoke changing area consisting of two shipping containers)."



Put the Mower Away for May

Nuneaton residents are being asked to protect plants and insects by leaving their lawnmowers in the shed and embracing No Mow May.

The No Mow May initiative, which is run by the charity Plantlife, encourages people to let their lawns grow wild in May to give smaller plants a chance to grow and to support pollinators.

Although April and May are traditionally the time when lawnmowers are released from sheds and garages, keeping them locked up for a little longer means grass and wildflowers have more time to grow naturally. By doing this, lawns can provide a vital habitat for a range of insects, such as bees, butterflies and moths.

Warwickshire County Council already follow the ethos of No Mow May throughout the year and roadside grass verges are only cut back when necessary to keep our roads and pavements safe.

Sarah Stear, Warwickshire County Council's Head of Climate Change and Sustainability, said: "No Mow May is a fantastic opportunity for residents across Warwickshire to help support our local wildlife. By allowing our lawns to grow wild for a few more days, we can create a vital habitat for pollinators and other insects and make a positive difference to the environment. And if you ever needed an excuse for not mowing the lawn, this is it!"

Plantlife's research has shown that allowing the grass to grow for just one month can significantly increase the number of flowers in a lawn, providing valuable nectar and pollen for insects. The charity also recommends delaying the first cut until late summer or early autumn, to allow time for the flowers to set seed and continue to support wildlife.

Family Fun Day

Bulkington Village Centre (BVC) a local charitable organisation dedicated to developing a financially self-supporting community centre where all surplus funds are ploughed back in for the benefit of local people. To improve the quality of life for the local community and to promote the benefits of social welfare by providing activities in the fields of education, culture, health, and entertainment.

BVC is thrilled to announce its 25th anniversary and a special fundraising event to continue its work in developing and refurbishing the centre. Established in 1996 and officially opened by the mayor in May 2000, BVC was originally Bulkington First School opened on 25th September 1939 (delayed 2 weeks because of the outbreak of war) Due to the need to reduce school places throughout the county in 1996, Bulkington First School was closed. However, after a huge outcry from village residents, it was decided to try and save the building for community use. The result being Bulkington Village Centre (BVC). BVC, now a charitable company, (Charity No: 1071175) has become a multiactivity community centre. This unique project is run by a board of local unpaid volunteers and small team of paid employees. The Centre has drawn together a blend of statutory and community services on one site. These include a Doctors Surgery, NHS Clinic & Occupational Therapists, Phlebotomy Service, Nursery, and the centre also provides rooms for hire at subsidised rates for the community for social. educational and cultural activities. BVC houses over 70 regular weekly community activity groups ranging from arts & crafts, health & fitness, as well as providing affordable entertainment: live music, quiz nights, film & fish suppers & more. We strive to offer more and to develop the use of the Centre, based on the community and users' needs. A grant from the National Lottery gave BVC the opportunity to



carry out

major refurbishment and to turn what was then a 62 year old building into a more modern facility. Now a 90 year old building, the refurbishment and development continues but with very little funding available BVC continues to work hard to self-finance all projects and repairs. "We are so proud to have reached this huge milestone of 25 years. We have fantastic support from the local community and wanted to not only celebrate with the community and showcase the centre, but an important aspect of our organisation is to raise funds to enable us to continue to develop the site & services. Our next project being to refurbish the toilet block and add additional disabled and baby changing facilities. More importantly, hopefully attracting new families to the centre, bringing people together for a day of fun! Quote from the BVC Manager about the importance of the anniversary," says Fiona Wyatt-Lynch, Centre Manager at Bulkington Village Centre (BVC)
